Dear Friends - At Easter we celebrate the great reality that Jesus – God incarnate – has redeemed us, through His sacrifice on the cross and victory over death. Over these days, we ponder what He suffered for love of us, and are invited to turn back to Him, to repent and to change.

If it has been a while – even many years since your last confession – do not be afraid! Confession to a priest can be done anonymously (behind a screen) or, if you prefer, face-to-face. In our parish, confessions will be available on Tuesday 31st March at 8.00pm, on Good Friday (3rd April) 12 noon - 1.00pm, after the 3.00pm service and from 8.15pm onwards, and on other days/times by request. There are leaflets in the Church porch on how to prepare for confession, and the priest will be happy to guide you.
