PROCESSION IN HONOUR OF OUR LADY: Our fifth Annual Procession in honour of Our Lady will take place on Sunday 17th May at 2pm, beginning at the Upper Site of OLSG School, followed by the walk along Shernhall Street to the Church, where the rosary will be prayed in a number of languages. Save the date and come along!

CONFIRMATION: The next Confirmation session will take place this Sunday, 3rd May at 4pm in the Parish Hall.

FIRST COMMUNION: There will be First Holy Communions at all of the Masses this weekend, and next weekend. Next weekend, 7 children will receive First Communion at the Saturday 6pm Mass, 12 at 10am and 15 at 12 noon.

MASS BOOKINGS: Please note that all weekday Masses are booked until the end of May, and all weekend Masses are booked until mid-August 2015. When requesting weekend Masses, please book at least six months in advance to avoid disappointment. The 6pm Mass on Saturday evening is the most popular, so we recommend requesting intentions for this Mass a year in advance.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION: There are currently some slots available for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Mondays, 12-1pm, 1-2pm and 3pm-4pm. We do require at least a couple of people to be present at all times when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed.
