## 7<sup>th</sup> June 2015 SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI (B)

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ or Corpus Christi. We celebrate the Holy Eucharist: the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ made present in the Holy Mass and reserved in the church tabernacle. Vatican II declared that the Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life". All the sacraments make possible a contact with the Risen Christ. However, in the Holy Eucharist we actually behold the bodily and spiritual presence of Christ Himself. The Holy Eucharist is truly, really and substantially the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

Each time we receive Holy Communion, we are changed by Christ. We are drawn nearer to Christ and enter into a deeper friendship with Him. Christ transforms us into the people that God wishes us to be in this life and for all eternity. Saint Pope John Paul II said that, 'those who feed on Christ in the Eucharist need not wait until the hereafter to receive eternal life: they already possess it on earth, as the first-fruits of a future fullness which will embrace humanity in its totality.'

This Sunday at the 10.00 Mass, we also celebrate a First Holy Communion thanksgiving with all the children who made their First Holy Communion in May this year. I would like to thank the parents and catechists for their wonderful support during the preparation period. The children received their First Holy Communion with great devotion and prayerfulness. We pray that the Lord Jesus Christ will sustain them in their faith and lives in the years ahead.
