**Third Sunday of Lent (A)**

In the Gospel today, Jesus is tired after a long walk. We see His humanity. He is thirsty, and sits down beside a well to rest. At the well he meets a Samaritan woman, and a conversation begins.

This woman has been searching for happiness through a string of relationships, and it has only brought her pain and deep hurt. Jesus helps her to face the reality of her situation, and she begins to perceive the condition of her soul. This causes her to long for healing and wholeness.

Christ meets us where we are. As with the woman at the well, He makes us aware of our own emptiness, weakness and sinfulness. Jesus does this not to reject or condemn us, but so that we will open wide to him the door of our soul. He tells us to look for the living water that He gives, the spiritual water that satisfies the soul.

How do we get this spiritual water? It comes to us through the encounter with Christ. Jesus encountered this woman when she was rejected and vulnerable, and likewise He can meet us in our sinfulness and weakness, no matter the situation. He leads us into a deeper relationship with Him, so that we will find our fulfilment in Him. Our encounter with Jesus comes through prayer, through reading the Word of God, and through the Sacraments of the Church – in all of these, Christ is present to us, helping us to find healing and peace.

**FORMED FOR LOVE:** An International Theology of the Body Symposium for Young Adults, at St Patrick's Soho Square, London W1D4NR, 19-22 April 2017. The event spreads the joy of St John Paul II's teaching on God's plan for human love. This year we are hosting two distinct events in an effort to bring these teachings to not only young adults but to enable teachers to bring the message into their classrooms.

**Formed for Love - Educator's Day – New Approaches to Teaching on Human Sexuality:** On 19 April 2017 there will be a one-day **seminar for Catholic Educators** with keynote lectures from Professor William Newton (Franciscan University of Steubenville, USA). This day will enable educators to understand the Catholic vision of the human person, drawing particularly, but not exclusively, from St. John Paul II's Theology of the Body. We then will explore how this understanding of the human person can be applied to 'hot topics' such as same-sex marriage, gender theory, and euthanasia, before moving on to explore different ways to tackle these topics with young people living in our current culture.

**Formed for Love - International Symposium for Young Adults:** The International Symposium for Young Adults (aged 18-35 years) will be held from 19 April (evening) - 22 April 2017. The symposium will offer an opportunity to explore the teachings of St. John Paul II.
