## FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT (19/12/2021)

(Expectant Mothers)

Dear Parishioners,

In these last few hectic days before Christmas, practical help is worth anything. Everyone is so busy, even small gestures of kindness can be a treasure. Families will value the baby-sitter who will mind young children while the elders go out, to socialise or to buy presents, or to prepare a good reception for Santa Claus. In these short few days, people have so much to do, there can be less time for civility, less time for thoughtfulness.

The Gospel this Sunday suggests a kinder approach. It describes Mary's visit to her cousin Elizabeth, as family, and helper. Mary, don't forget, had barely recovered from the traumatic experience of being told she was to be the Mother of God. But instead of wallowing in the shock that the announcement from the angel must have surely brought, she hot foots it all the way to her cousin Elizabeth's home, quite a distance, in times when a ride on a donkey luxurious as travel got. At her Annunciation she heard the angel say that her cousin Elizabeth was six months pregnant-so Mary figured that this older lady could do with a bit of assistance. Giving practical help was her priority, so she not only visited Elizabeth but stayed with her three months, till the baby was born.

The Visitation of Mary is a hefty challenge to Christians getting ready to celebrate another birth, that of Mary's son. Mary's practical attentiveness is a call to us busy creatures to look out for each other, even in these days. The rarest things will be the most appreciated: courteous drivers, customers who

thank those who serve them, appreciative clients, people prepared to go the extra mile to see that others are cared for, before themselves: doing as Mary would have done.
