Fifth Sunday of Lent (26/03/2023)

'I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?' A profound statement, absolute assurance, and a challenging question on which we could ponder. Resurrection is not 'something' that happens after death. Resurrection is Someone whose life we share now. To believe in Jesus is to be in an intimate, trusting relationship-it is not knowledge. To believe and live is the same thing. Because we are live is the same thing. Because we are alive now in the risen Jesus, we are in Heaven. However, Heaven is not a place but a person-the Risen Jesus. And he is not somewhere. He is everywhere. It is in him we live, move, and have our being. He promised, 'I go to prepare a place for you, so that where I am, you may be too'. Where Jesus is, we are. St. George of Nazianzus bolsters our confidence in simple, yet profound language: 'We needed an incarnate God who would die that we might live. We died with him that we might live. We died with him that we might be cleansed. We rose again with him because we died with him. We were glorified with him because we rose again with him.' Speaking about His Ascension, St Augustine says, 'Just as he ascended without leaving us, so too we are already with him in Heaven, although his promise have not yet been fulfilled in our bodies. Christ, while in Heaven is also with us; and we, while on earth, are also with him. He did not leave Heaven when he came down to us from heaven; and He did not leave us when he ascended to heaven again.' Speaking of Heaven, Pope Benedict writes, 'The departing Jesus does not make his way to some distant star. Hence, he has not 'gone away,' but now and forever by God's own power he is present with us and for us. His going away is in this sense a coming, a new form of closeness of continuing presence.
