PROCESSION IN HONOUR OF OUR LADY: Our fifth Annual Procession in honour of Our Lady will take place next Sunday 17th May at 2pm, beginning at the Upper Site of OLSG School, followed by the walk along Shernhall Street to the Church, where the rosary will be prayed in a number of languages, and Fr Maurice will consecrate the parish to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. All are encouraged to attend.
