### **Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (B) (01/08/2021)**

Dear Parishioners,

Pier Paolo Pasolini (1922-1975) was an Italian writer, journalist, novelist, politician and film producer. In 1964, the film, 'The Gospel According to St Mathew' was written and produced by Pasolini. Yet, despite being called Peter Paul, he was an ardent Marxist! The focus of the film is on Jesus as a man of the people intent on delivering them from all that oppressed them. It is one of the best films about Jesus. But the final scenes of the film covering the tragic denouement in Jerusalem and the resurrection don't work because Pasolini cannot accept that this is the pivotal point of the life and ministry of Jesus.

Every generation seems to have a take at remaking Jesus in terms of its current occupations and interests. We can see this in the depiction of Jesus in 'Jesus Christ Superstar' and 'Godspell'. The making of idols to suit ourselves is a persistent temptation. The immediate followers of Jesus had the same problem. They loved him, followed him, attended closely to what he said and did, but struggled to understand him, because he did not fit in neatly to categories of what they expected in an inspiring religious leader.

Today's Gospel has the crowd searching for Jesus. He reminds them that they are looking for him for all the wrong reasons. Jesus takes them by surprise. He leads them into a situation where he makes God accessible to them through the everyday symbol of bread.

What would be abstract, hard to grasp, beyond human understanding is summed up in someone right in front of them, an approachable human being who wants to feed their famished hearts with the lasting food of God's

forgiveness and friendship. It is a reminder to us that we can never reduce the Gospel message or the person of Jesus to the narrow agenda of our own seductive culture and notions.

Later this week, we will celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration. Jesus opens a new inner dimension for his disciples to glimpse and understand. They will be dazzled by the experience of the future glory that is promised by Christ. This happens whenever we listen as God's Word is voiced (under a cloud!) to us in the whirlwind mayhem of our lives today.
